

A feed supplement for Ewes carrying twin lambs when metabolic disorders occur.

- Provides a high level of essential energy which is often in a depleted state in in-lamb ewes. The glycerine / emulsified fats give instantly available energy giving her an essential respite during which her own metabolism can resume normal working.
- The Vetoxan permits improved digestion of normal feeding during this period

NOTES: Twin Lamb Acetonaemia

an acute metabolic disorder occurring in ewes carrying twins/triplets or large single lambs during the last few weeks of pregnancy. Normally induced by short period of reduced feeding (often caused by bad weather) Affected Ewe loses co-ordination of movement and often staggers/falls. In general appearance the Ewe is dull with hanging head and staring eyes with laboured breathing and fluid may be discharged from her nostrils. A comatose condition then develops.

Instructions

Feed 100ml to Ewe at the first sign of metabolic disorder

Repeat if necessary
